



The main rivers and tributaries in the Brecks and Fen Edge





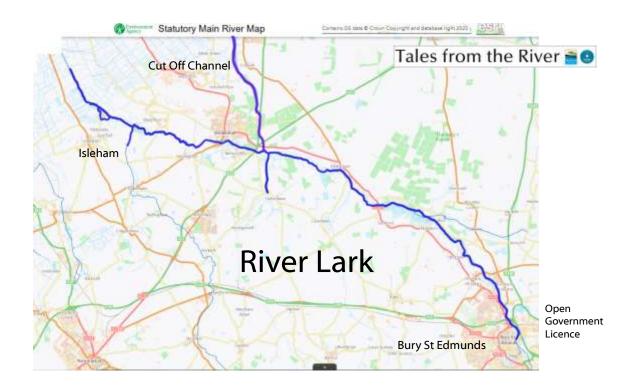














